Carlos Earnest Harris, 76, passed away on November 21, 2023 at Washington Center in San Leandro, California. He was born in Washington, D.C. on November 30, 1946 to Charles and Elizabeth Harris.

Carlos attended Bluefield High in West Virginia and played on the high school football team. After graduating, he joined the Army at the age of 18. He served in Germany then was transferred to Vietnam. He received a Vietnam Service Medal with 2 Bronze Stars, a Vietnam Campaign Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge (1st Award) 2 Overseas Bars and a Marksman (M-14). After proudly serving in the Army, Carlos attended Bluefield College in West Virginia. He then moved to Colorado and became a coal miner. After several years, Carlos moved to Hayward, California and became a nursing assistant where he met his wife, Deanna. Carlos and Deanna married in 1985 in Castro Valley, California then moved to Fremont, California. Carlos held various job positions, including a physical therapy assistant working alongside his wife. Carlos retired in 2008. While in retirement, Carlos enjoyed fishing and talking politics with his best friend, Frank Valle, who stuck with him like a brother until the end. Carlos had a love of news and current affairs and debate. He often practiced at the shooting and archery range and watched many western and action movies. All his life, he had a passion for caring for cats.

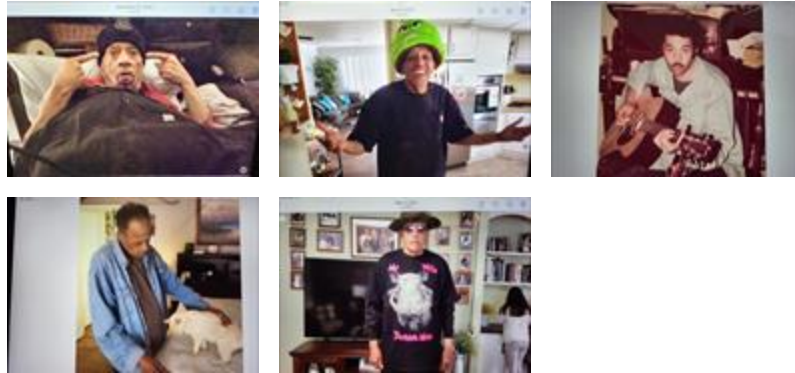

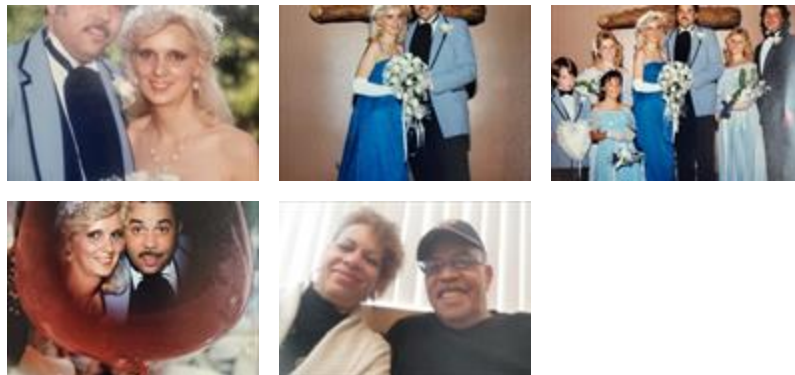
