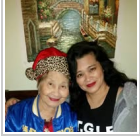

“ Known to everyone as Charlie, was born on May 1, 1945 in Manila as a US citizen.

He served proudly in the Marines in Vietnam, worked as an airline mechanic for most of his life, and on various whims, would open different businesses throughout the years. For example, he had a lobster boat, an auto repair shop, and a restaurant.

He and his wife were together 53 years and raised many kids in addition to their two daughters. Their home was always open to friends and family. There were multiple times where friends and family would move in and he would not realize it until after a year passed. Eventually it would dawn on him that they didn't seem to go home.

He would later quietly ask Juliet about it, never wanting the guest to feel uncomfortable or unwelcomed.

He was a quiet man, who didn't often smile in pictures and most thought of him as strict, especially since when he spoke it was often in a commanding tone. That being said, many didn't know he had a goofy, silly side, making up words and phrases, passing them off as if they were from the Philippines. He was always telling crazy stories to his kids and grandkids, making it up as he went along. He was protective of those he loved, especially the women in his life and could not stand to see them suffer. Many would run to the home he and Juliet built for support and shelter.

He was a musician, playing in bands most of his life, including "The Downbeats" in Manila, who opened for the Beatles in the 60's, The "Rojo Family Band" in San Francisco in the 70s, and "Where's Charlie" in Atlanta in the 80s and 90s.

He was an enthusiastic collector... cars, motorcycles, boats, guitars, musical equipment, guns, swords, coins and anything else he thought would be of value, much to the dismay of his kids and wife, since he would collect them usually in multiples of 3, 5 or 15 at a time. He loved fishing, camping, boating and had a special connection to Paradise Cove, Lake Pyramid, Lake Berryessa, and the Van Ness Pier. He was an award winning skeet shooter.

He will be missed, but will be remembered often. While he had to step off stage, we know he is back with a few of the members of his original bands and they are having an awesome Jam Session for the Angels.
