Dennis George Osorio (69), was called to heaven on November 17, 2022 after a 9-year battle with stage 4 cancer.

Dennis was born in San Francisco, California on February 18, 1953 to the late George and Gloria Osorio from Sunnyvale, California. He is survived by his wife Peggy, having been married for almost 5 decades. He is also survived by his 3 children, Stephen Osorio, Daniel Osorio (Esmeralda), and Desiree Osorio.
