Utufaasili Lagimaina Poutasi L. Tuiatua Laufasa, 68, joined the Lord on Monday, January 22, 2018, at Queen's Medical Center in Honolulu, Hawaii, after a short battle with cancer. She was born on January 26, 1949 in Sataua, Samoa to parents Leuluataatasi Mamea and Elena Fulisia Mataeliga. She was eldest of ten children, and had six brothers, and three sisters.
